## About Debian

Debian is an operating system consisting entirely of Free and Open Source Software. The Debian Project is dedicated to remaining 100% free and to being a responsible “citizen” of this ecosystem. We are committed to Free Software and our users, our two priorities.

Debian runs in hundreds of schools thanks to SkoleLinux, and powers gaming platforms with SteamOS. Debian has been deployed in public institutions such as the cities of Munich and Vienna, and the German Federal Office for Information Security (BSI)..

Debian is produced by over a thousand active developers, spread across the globe, many of whom volunteer in their spare time. Outside of conferences, most communication takes place on the Internet, in mailing lists and IRC chat rooms.

Unlike all other Linux distributions of similar size, Debian is an independent non-profit organization.

## About MiniDebConf and MiniDebCamp

While there is just one DebConf throughout the year, there are multiple MiniDebConfs organized all around the world.

MiniDebCamp means having a venue and infrastructure for discussions, hacking sessions, team sprints, workshops ...all about Debian.

MiniDebCamp and MiniDebConf goals are:

- **Enable face-to-face interactions**  
Intense technical discussions at DebConf can shortcut weeks or months of mailing list threads.
- **Provide live talks also as video streams and recordings**  
Recordings can be used by Debian contributors and others anywhere in the world for free.
- **Provide time to work on Debian during DebCamp**  
It is very valuable to have uninterrupted time to work on Debian contributions.
- **Motivate contributors**  
People feel lucky to be sponsored to attend. It increases the enthusiasm of many attendees, and ultimately makes them better citizens of the Debian community.
- **Motivate the local community**  
MiniDebConf leads to a greater involvement in Debian from locals in the region where it is held.

## MiniDebConf Winterthur 2026

After the famous DebConf 2013 and MiniDebConf 2019 in Vaumarcus (Neuchâtel/Neuenburg), the Swiss community is organizing a MiniDebConf again!

MiniDebConf Winterthur is taking place August 29th to 30th 2026. It is a free event open to everyone, regardless their level of knowledge about Debian. The most important aspect is bringing together the community, to work together, learn from each other and celebrate one of the largest Free Software projects in the world. We welcome everyone from inexperienced users who just begin their journey with Debian to official project developers that are with Debian since decades.
